Background Scripture: Judges 16:18-21 KJV

Jumpstart and Review:

- *Hair was a sign of Dedication to God in a Nazarite Vow & it was the source of Samson's anointing!
- *Unusual twist to Nazarite Vow. They're typically short-term vows but Samson's was for LIFE!
- *Samson was dedicated to God ceremonially by his parents & he loosely observed the vow. This nonchalant attitude helped to create a climate of "clumsy"!
- ***Dedicate:** to devote, set aside or assign (time, effort or oneself) to a particular task, purpose or function.
- ***Clumsy:** awkward in movement or action; without skill or grace:
- * **Anointed AHA #1:** Clumsy can be a premature phase, not a permanent place. it's a STAGE not a STATUS!
- ***HOW DO I CANCEL "CLUMSY"**

- Have Clear Boundaries (find the scripture in Judges 13-16 that speaks to this)**
- Hire a licensed Hairdresser**
