Background Scripture: Job 1:1-5 / Philippians 4:6 (NLT)

Jumpstart and Review:

Job's prosperity positioned him to shine for God!

He didn't need prosperity to shine, but his prosperity provided a greater platform for the light of God to shine in his life.

AHA #1: SATAN IS THREATENED BY ANYBODY W/ KINGDOM INFLUENCE.

Worry & Fear disengage THE BLESSING in our lives, but Jesus reminds us in Matthew 6:25 (NLT) *That is why I tell you not to worry about everyday life—whether you have enough food and drink, or enough clothes to wear. Isn't life more than food, and your body more than clothing?*

Philippians 4:6 (NLT)

Don't worry about anything; instead, pray about everything. Tell God what you need, and thank him for all he has done.

Why do we give WORRY permission into our lives? Somewhere we believed the lie that WORRY was a sign of being more responsible.

- WORRY is an Irresponsible use or TIME, TALENT & RESOURCES.

Now, if you're GUILTY of something:

- GET IT OFF of you (in other words confess it)
- GET IT RIGHT (repent) &
- GET ON WITH IT (be big enough to deal w/ the consequences)
