Background Scripture: II Corinthians 10:4-5

⁴ (For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds;) ⁵ Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;

Jumpstart and Review:

- We do not have the luxury of playing or being cordial with sin; ... it must always be cast down!
- God is straightforward with His Charity (Love), Conviction, Correction & Consequences. There are no addendums to His Grace. So anything “EXTRA” that supersedes or overshadows His previous Word(s) should be actively refuted & when necessary; rebuked!
- We must earnestly contend for the faith (particularly faith in the Word of God), especially when its integrity & immutability is being challenged. This requires a belief that is rooted well enough to withstand the winds of opposition, challenge & ridicule.

1. When was the last time your imagination had you do or say something foolish? Think back to the catalyst that gave that thought permission to run as wild as it did? How do you safeguard against that happening again?
