## Background Scripture: Genesis 1:26 /

And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth.

## Jumpstart and Review:

- The root word for imagination is IMAGE.
- Our imaginations are only as effective & relevant as the images they reflect.
- For the believer when the image of ourselves & our source (GOD) don't match, our ability to imagine becomes corrupted & unreliable.
- In justification, the blood of Jesus expunges every record of wrong.
- Everything that we ever did died with that old sinful man that we use to be;
- with his old sinful ways and his old sinful thoughts and his old sinful behaviors and responses!
- Justification restores our spiritual likeness, and our Kingdom Character is continually being developed in us through the process of SANCTIFICATION.
- As believers, we are to reflect the glory of the Lord just like Moses did when he came out of the Presence of God with the 10 Commandments!
- BUT THERE IS A DIFFERENCE!
- For Moses the glory eventually faded away, but under the new covenant, the believer doesn't just reflect the image, WE ARE CHANGED INTO THE SAME IMAGE.
- This transformation takes place by our POSITION IN, REVERENCE OF & OBEDIENCE TO the Abiding Presence of the Spirit of God.
  - POSTION IN: It matters where I stand!
  - REVERENCE OF: My actions/reactions, etc. shouldn't constantly disrespect God.
    - I shouldn't consistently be doing the opposite of what He's doing!
  - OBEDIENCE TO: God's WILL should be my WANT!
