Background Scripture: Proverbs 29:18 (NASB)

Where there is no vision, the people are unrestrained, But happy is he who keeps the law.

Jumpstart and Review:

- VISION: A mental picture of a future state; a preview of a preferred or proposed outcome.
- Every vision isn't pretty and we won't "revel" @ every revelation, but those are His will ultimately rejoice in the end (ref. Romans 8:28)
- KINGDOM VISION REQUIRES COMMITMENT
- Commitment: the innate ability to "stick & stay," regardless the situation, circumstance or condition
- Commitment is a "giving word" & "giving words" don't seem to do we in "taking cultures," but commitment is precisely required for proper vision implementation because:
 - 1. VISION IS REPETATIVE (ref. Genesis 6 Noah preached, "It's going to rain" for 120 yrs.)
 - 2. VISION IS REDUCTIVE (*Committed "Vision-eers" standout easily b/c* they're typically the only ones still willing to risk everything for what they were shown long after the hype, excitement & "newness" are gone)
 - 3. VISION IS REDEEMING (the REWARD is REVEALED only to those who REMAIN)

Q.F.C. (Questions for Consideration)

1. Is it possible to confuse a commitment to VISION for pride in your investment (time, life, energy, resources) to said VISION? How do we distinguish between the two and combat the latter?

2. Have you ever been the "last man/woman standing" for something that you were deeply committed to? What made you stick it out; PRIDE, or your hope to see what God had said?
