Background Scripture: Ephesians 4:3, Proverbs 12:16 (KJV) (MSG) <u>Jumpstart and Review:</u>

When unresolved issues are tolerated within relationships (esp the Church), the resulting unsettledness wreaks havoc on those involved. Health emerges in relationships (esp. the Church) when those involved promote & encourage a sense of unity in the bond of love (peace) (ref. Eph. 4:3). Possessing this trait doesn't mean that everyone in a relationship (esp. the Church) always agrees with everyone else or that there are never any problems. It simply means that when problems do occur, we take the time & effort to resolve them in a timely manner. No relationship (esp. the Church) is problem-free, nor should we expect it to be.
