Background Scripture: Daniel 2:20-21 (NRSV)

Blessed be the name of God from age to age, for wisdom and power are His. He changes times and seasons, deposes kings and sets up kings; he gives wisdom to the wise and knowledge to those who have understanding.

Jumpstart and Review:

As churches, we tend to favor stability over change. Often our greatest unspoken goal is to arrive at a good at a good place and then stay put. But an irresistible church chooses to constantly learn and adapt. Change is the currency of a constantly shifting society, and what worked yesterday to minister to that society may not always work today.

The main emphasis is never placed on just being relevant, current, or cool.

Instead, the emphasis is on staying effective and mission conscious – and our mission as Kingdom Citizens is to keep the Kingdom of Heaven moving in Jesus' name and that often requires CHANGE.

QFC (Questions For Consideration)

1. Read Proverbs 14:4 (NLT), then discuss the thought, "If our goal is a clean manger, we won't have any strength or effectiveness."

2. Why is it dangerous for a church to change just for the sake of change alone? Is it ever possible to change too much, too quickly, or for the wrong reasons?

3. What is one action you can take this week toward learning something new?
