## Background Scripture: Exodus 14:21-22 Joshua 3:15-17 Jumpstart and Review:

\*Growth – the act or process, or manner of growing; development; gradual increase.

\*Spiritual growth requires your active participation.

\*Growth had taken place with the Israelites between Exodus and Joshua.

- They grew from running from a fight, to pursuing the fight.
- They grew from focusing behind them to focusing on what was in front of them.

\*Simple Truth: if change has not taken place, then growth has not taken place.

- We have not grown if we have not changed.

Point 1: God has brought you this far to take you further.

• Because you are still on this earth is a testament that God has more for you to do.

Point 2: Sometimes it will feel like God is not with you

• God is omniscient and omnipresent. If He is everywhere at the same time; it is impossible for Him to leave you.

Point 3: Don't expect God to do a new thing the old way.

• Just because God delivered that way last time, doesn't mean He will deliver that way again this time.
