**Background Scripture: Matthew 28:16-20 (NASB)**

**Jumpstart and Review:** The text in context has Jesus resurrected from the dead. Roman guards have been bribed to lie & say that the disciples *jacked* the body. Disciples go to Galilee, & find Jesus in the mountain.

\*Galilee: the place of the circle or circuit; *the heathen circle*

\*The next characteristic of an **IRRESISTIBLE CHURCH**, a church that God loves to bless, is that **She Connects Everything She Does To A Soul.**

- That means that everything that we do should in some way connect, and assist in saving the lost and helping people grow in faith.

\*We are not meant to be a subculture, separate unto ourselves, we are commanded to be a counterculture!

- We cannot settle for being a community of believers rallying around ourselves & things that only make us comfortable.
- Everything we do should be purposeful, polarizing & passionately predictable

\*Because our work as **CHRIST-LIKE** believers has **Eternal Consequences.**

\***AN IRRESISTIBLE CHURCH**, a church that God loves to bless, never forgets her assignment.
