Jumpstart and Review:

The phrase "Palm Sunday" comes from a well-known gesture reserved for Royalty and returning war heroes.

How Can We Develop A Committed Faith? #1. A Committed Faith Is Not Self-Centered; But Christ-Centered Sounds obvious, but we often miss it. Many times, we say to God, "*Here's is my* schedule, here's my agenda... Get in where you fit in."

#2. A Committed Faith Is Relationship Driven. A Committed Faith comes only through a personal relationship with Jesus Christ. It's through Jesus Christ that we learn how to stand when everything in us screams lay down and give up!

#3. A Committed Faith Is Not Moved By Our Personal Trials And Crises. A Committed Faith takes the good with the bad, knowing that God is right there with us every step of the way!
