Background Scripture: Isaiah 43:19 / Luke 24:1-12 / 2 Corinthians 5:17

## Jumpstart and Review:

Just because you're in a "DEAD PLACE" doesn't mean that you have to be!

- Esp. when the "GREATER ONE" lives on the inside of you! The greatness in you is accessed only through the great one!

? What does that really mean?

## Two different responses to the resurrection are recorded here:

- 1. To the other disciples, it seemed like idle talk & therefore kept them stationary (vs.11)
- 2. But to Peter, the same information initiated a different response he got up & ran towards the tomb (vs. 12)
  - What causes one to REJECT and another to RECEIVE?
    - o THE STRENGTH OF THEIR RELATIONSHIP
      - Peter's relationship with Jesus determined how he REACTED to the information.
    - O React: to respond to a stimulus in a particular manner;

The Urban Dictionary defines "Brand New" as: acting a certain way or displaying characteristics that are not congruent with one's normal behavior.
