<u>Jumpstart and Review:</u>

Our desire for solutions hasn't diminished, but our direction & discernment in where to find them has. We want answers but we don't want accountability.

Many of us want what WORKS minus WORSHIP. Many of us want GUARANTEES minus GOD.

We want our emotions touched & our intellect engaged minus God's Presence ... BUT God's Presence was what we were created to invoke, and worship teaches us how to do that.

Ephesians 1:12 says that, "we were created to the praise of God's glory"... We were created for God-worship & when we fail to do what we were created to do, everything suffers. Everything is out of place when we don't worship God correctly.

Whenever we take what belongs to God & give it to some thing or someone else, everything under us & under our authority suffers & struggles b/c everything under us & under our authority is following our lead!

Worship the Central Issue After Salvation for the Kingdom Citizen.

When we make getting into God's Presence a prioritized habit, there's NO WAY that we can tell God who He is & He NOT tell us WHO WE ARE!
